

Follow-up to Letter to the Judiciary

Re. Defendant Chris Gaines, attempted drug distribution

- 22 Mar 06 MKS: Total of five letters (one from ANC and four others) coordinated by the CCPS and sent to prosecuting AUSA.
- 24 Mar 06 MKS: Sentencing delayed due to defense not having enough time to review allocation letters before the scheduled sentencing on May 31, 2006.
- 31 May 06 MKS: Defendant Gains "being held" and sentencing now scheduled for July 7, 2006. His defense lawyer did not show up.
- 7 Jul 06 MKS: Defendant Gaines was sentenced on the following cases: 2005-FEL-6295 (Distribution of Cocaine) to 24 months incarceration, 5 years supervised release and \$100 VVCC assessment; 2006-CF2-4570 (Felony Contempt of Court) 12 months incarceration, 5 years supervised release and \$100 VVCC assessment. The sentence in this case is to run consecutively to that in 2005-FEL-6295, for a total of 36 months (that is, 3 years) incarceration. The prosecutors stated that the community impact letters had their intended effect.
