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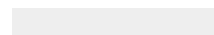

I actually live a block away and I took these pictures by stepping up on the hinge of the adjoining fence and looking over the picket fence. The picket fence is only about 6 feet tall. If the inspector cannot see into the rear fence, how can he/she report that the problem had been abated in the first place? Maybe he/she could bring a small step stool and look over the fence? I'll gladly provide that if needed. The fence has cracks that you can look through as well.

Please help us get this resolved as in the interim the rats continue to multiply. We first reported this problem back on July 21, 2006.
