

## **ANC2F Committee on Crime and Public Safety (CCPS)**

Purpose: To advise the Commission with respect to matters of crime and public safety which may affect the community, with a view of abating crime and increasing public safety. (as per the ANC resolution forming the CCPS)

Specific goals for discussion:

1) Legislative: Influence the legislative and regulatory environment to deter crime and increase public safety. Review existing statutory and regulatory materials which need revision or improvement. Identify pending legislation for further ANC support or action. Explore additional initiatives.

- a) Develop point of contact listing.
- b) Partner with Councilmember Evans.
- c) Formulate and recommend ANC positions to take on legislation.

2) Judiciary: Provide for community presence (i.e. “the victim”) in the courtroom, to include court watch, coordination of cases with the US Attorney 3D Prosecution Group and coordination of letter writing (allocution) campaigns for crimes/criminals that most impact the community.

- a) Write a “boilerplate” letter to the judiciary regarding the crimes of prostitution, theft, assault and drug distribution and their impact on the community.
- b) Develop contact listing: judges & prosecutors
- c) Partner with MPD and 3<sup>rd</sup> District Prosecutors to develop situational awareness of pending cases.
- d) Engage in letter writing campaigns and establish court room presence as required.

3) Awareness, deterrence and environment: Increase public/private vigilance, bring city services to the Logan Circle area to deter the criminal element, reduce the factors that make Logan Circle conducive to crime.

- a. Write letters to property owners when the property contributes in a non-positive way to the safety of the community. Follow-up on those letters.
- b. Bring city services to the community. Utilize the city request for services web page to bring city services to each SMD. Track and monitor progress. Partner with city agencies, to include the Office of Neighborhood Services, to determine agreed to service levels and fulfill ANC service requests. Utilize CORE team meetings to achieve objectives. Appoint individual to conduct analysis of CCPS entries into the city service request web page. Write letters as needed.
- c. Conduct public meetings on crime and public safety every two months.
- d. Review the results of the Ad Hoc Task Force on alcoholic beverages, specifically the recommendations of the Task Force to limit single sales. Explore implementation of this recommendation.

e. Serve as advocate for appropriate MPD policies, equipping and manning.

4) Expand reach and leverage of ANC2F initiatives by developing synergy with other community and governmental activities.

a) Establish representation on the 3d District Police Citizens Advisory Committee.

b) Develop contact listing of community and governmental activities, to include every ANC around ANC2F and community associations.

5) Operate the Committee by developing internal committee structure.  
a. Appoint individual to keep and maintain the master point of contact listing.

b. Maintain meeting minutes.

c. Place into the public view appropriate documentation, manage web page.

d. Conduct internal and external meetings.

e. Follow-up and bring to closure CCPS actions.
